Police Department of the Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 96-376

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation receives funds from the Customs Service of the Federal Government of the United States of America through "Asset Sharing", as a result of the participation of the Nation's Police Department in law enforcement activities that involve the seizure and forfeiture of property; and

WHEREAS, these funds would be useful in: training police officers, purchasing and maintaining equipment, and otherwise improving the operations of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the Tohono O'odham Nation has submitted a budget for expending these funds, and this budget has been reviewed and approved by the Executive Office, the appropriate oversight committees and the Budget & Finance Committee of the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation that the Asset Sharing Budget of the Tohono O'odham Police Department is approved as submitted,

in the amount of \$61,569.98 provided that the amount expended under this authority does not at any time exceed the amount remitted by the U.S. Customs Service to the Nation under Asset Sharing activities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in that amount are hereby appropriated in support of the activities described in the attached budget from payment made to the Tohono O'odham Nation by the U.S. Customs Service under Asset Sharing.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 22ND. day of AUGUST, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,771.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 105.0 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f), of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
