**RESOLUTION NO. 96-378**

**WHEREAS, the BIA Papago Agency presented to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council the projected base amounts for FY 1998; and**

**WHEREAS, the Papago Agency submitted the Tribal Priority Allocation programs, consolidated funding and staffing allocation levels and Decision Ranking Charts to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**

**WHEREAS, the priority Decision Ranking Charts provide the Tohono O'odham Nation the opportunity to participate in the Federal/Budget formulation process for the allocation and ranking of resources; and**

**WHEREAS, the priority Decision Ranking Charts, as utilized depict the Nations priorities as previously established; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the proposed Decision Ranking Charts as submitted.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the following Decision Ranking Charts be adopted for FY 1998 for the top five (5) priorities:**
