

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Tohono O'odham Library Services U.S. Department of Education**  
**Grant No. R163A50190)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 96-388**

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4 **WHEREAS, the Department of Education, Library Services for Indian Tribes -**

6 **Basic Grants Program, has announced that the Tohono O'odham**  
7  
8 **Nation has been awarded a basic grant in the amount of four**  
9 **thousand two hundred thirty-two dollars (\$4,232.00); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Education Department submitted a grant**  
12 **proposal for the budget period from October 1, 1995 through**  
13 **September 30, 1996, for the purpose of purchasing much needed**  
14 **library books and supplies to be utilized by the Venito Garcia, San**  
15 **Xavier, and San Lucy libraries; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the deadline to expend this grant award is September 30, 1996.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
21 **Council does hereby approve the award from the Department of**  
22 **Education, Library Services for Indian Tribes - Basic Grants**  
23 **Programs, in the amount of \$4,232.00.**

26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**  
27 **Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman, and any**  
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designated official are hereby authorized to execute the grant,  
provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or  
funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for further approval.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the  
9TH. day of SEPTEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with  
a vote 1,715.5 FOR; 67.0 AGAINST; 93.5 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant  
to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f), of the Constitution  
of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on  
January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian  
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
