(FY 1996 Family Preservation Program Budget Modification No. 2)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 96-390**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Family Preservation Program under FY 1996, P.L. 93-638 grant with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

**WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**

**WHEREAS, the program period has been changed from August 31, 1995 through August 30, 1996 to October 01, 1995 to September 30, 1996 in accordance with the grant agreement and to cover over expenditures and expenses for the remainder of the FY 1996.**

**WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services - Division of Child Welfare Services/Family Preservation Program.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the amendment to the Family Preservation Program grant and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit; the Chairman, Vice Chairman, and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendment affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 9TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f), of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
