RESOLUTION NO. 96-394

WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act was enacted into law in 1982
replacing the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA);
and

WHEREAS, funding is made available to State and Tribal Governments to
establish programs for improving the employment prospects of
eligible persons through designation of service delivery areas; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona is entitled to JTPA funds to develop a network
of employment training programs throughout the State; and

WHEREAS, Indian Reservations in Arizona have been designated service delivery
areas and are eligible to receive State JTPA funds; and

WHEREAS, the JTPA program submits the following documents for review and
approval for the Title II-A Contract Proposal for Fiscal Year 1997;

- 1) Fiscal Year 1997 Administrative Cost Pool Budget reflecting the**
actual allocation amount of \$18,641; and
- 2) Fiscal Year 1997 Program Budget reflecting the actual allocation**
of \$99,420.

duration of the contract shall be from July 1, 1996 through June 30,

1999.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council authorizes the JTPA

Program to capture monies for Fiscal Year 1997 for period July 1,

1996 through June 30, 1999 as new monies and not as carryover

monies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the

Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman and any

designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute

the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the

funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for

further prior approval by this Council.


