RESOLUTION NO. 96-406

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, through its Planning and Operations Department seeks to apply for grant funds under the Arizona Housing Trust Fund Competitive Funding Cycle for 1996 to use for bathroom additions, improved water and wastewater resources located in Pia Oik Community, Gu Vo District, Pima County; and

WHEREAS, the total project cost for this proposal is \$385,000, those costs being \$361,000 for bathrooms construction and water/wastewater resources, and \$24,068 for costs of administration; and

WHEREAS, the grant amount available to fund this project is \$100,000 dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Operations Department is applying for \$100,000 (100%) of this grant amount; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is willing to contribute \$145,068 to the total cost of this project, provided the Housing Trust Fund Grant is awarded; and

WHEREAS, the following project is recommended for submission to the Arizona Housing Trust Fund Grant Program:


