

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Certification of Selection Criteria utilized for Selection of Recipients for
Arizona Housing Trust Fund Grant Program Funds - 1996)

RESOLUTION NO. 96-408

WHEREAS, the Arizona Housing Trust Fund Grant Program guidelines require selection criteria for identifying those families most in need of housing who will receive housing renovations and wastewater facilities through the 1996 Arizona Housing Trust Fund Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the District participating in the 1996 Arizona Housing Trust Fund Program (of the 11 Districts which comprise the Tohono O'odham Nation) defined its selection criteria on the basis of; low income families with elderly or handicapped members; low income families that lived in seriously overcrowded conditions; low income families living in a structurally unstable home or a home in urgent need of repairs; low income families with a home with no amenities (i.e. indoor plumbing, sewage, water or electrical systems); families with very low income not to exceed 50% of the median income for the area adjusted for family size; and low income families with an annual income that does not exceed 80% of median family income for the area adjusted for family size (the area being Metropolitan Standard Area for the Nation: Tucson, Arizona); and

WHEREAS, the District Council consulted with its own Housing Committees and reviewed the applicant list of the Tohono O'odham Housing Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Planning and Operations Department overtook a survey and cost estimate for each of the proposed building renovations and that the estimate conformed to standards of the National Association of Real Estate Appraisers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby adopts the proposed selected participants and projects for the Arizona Housing Trust Fund Grant Program for funding bathroom additions and water and wastewater improvements in Pia Oik, Gu Vo District.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 10TH. day of SEPTEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,654.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 222.0 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f), of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


