

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approval of the Nursing Home Project Set-Aside Budget of \$3,198,621.00 for  
FY 1997)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 96-417**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation did authorize  
(in Resolution Numbers 95-015, 95-016 and 95-113) the establishment  
of a Nursing Home Project Set Aside Account; and**

**WHEREAS, this account was established to provide the monies required to train  
O'odham to operate a Nursing Home facility, to plan the facility, to  
construct the facility and to initially operate the facility; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nursing Home Project has progressed to the point where it needs  
funds to educate O'odham, and to continue the planning process; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nursing Home Project has submitted the attached FY 1997  
budget explaining the need for \$3,198.621.00 to fund the  
expenditures expected to be incurred by this project during this  
fiscal year.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
Council that this budget for \$3,198,621.00 be approved.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nation's Chairman may enter into all  
contract required to execute the intent of this budget; and**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that since this budget establishes the funds for long term relationships with institutions of higher education and with consultants who's services will be required beyond this fiscal year; the Nation's Chairman is authorized to continue contracting or to establish new contracts or to establish other appropriate legal instruments (such as Intergovernmental Agreements) as is required to fulfill the intent of this budget so long as all expenditures are within the intent of and limits of this and any and all future budgets.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves and authorizes that a separate checking account be established for the Nursing Home Set-Aside Budget.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 11TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
