(Amendment to Resolution 838-85 (Establishing of the Apprenticeship  
Committee))**

**RESOLUTION NO. 96-427**

**WHEREAS, in recognizing the need for skilled craftworkers, the O'odham Tribal  
Council established apprenticeship standards to be used in the local  
apprenticeship program for the O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Standards require that an Apprenticeship Committee, to be  
known as the Tohono O'odham Nation Apprenticeship Committee,  
consisting of nine (09) members be appointed to administer and  
supervise said standards in accordance with the duties prescribed;  
and**

**WHEREAS, the standards would be effectively implemented by the Tohono  
O'odham Nation Apprenticeship Committee consisting of  
representatives of tribal programs and industries that are actively  
involved in aspect of employment and training, to wit:**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Tribal Council

that it does hereby establish and authorize an Apprenticeship Committee to consist of representatives from the following programs or industries: Employment Assistance, J.T.P.A., Career Center, T.E.R.O., T.W.E.P., Cyprus Tohono Corporation, Scholarship Program, Vi-Ikam Doag Industries and Indian Oasis Baboquivari School District #40; are hereby authorized to perform the duties contained in the "Standards of Apprenticeship and Training for the Tohono O'odham Nation".

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 12TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,689.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 187.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(b) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
