**RESOLUTION NO. 96-439**

**WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District Council has determined that in order for its administration and communities to function adequately, a budget needs to be established to meet their needs for Fiscal Year 1997; and**

**WHEREAS, on September 4, 1996 the Baboquivari District Council reviewed and approved their Fiscal Year 1997 budget; and**

**WHEREAS, Baboquivari District has sufficient funds in their District Account to cover the total amount of Fiscal Year 1997.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the proposed budget for Baboquivari District in the amount of \$586,262.89.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 13TH. day of SEPTEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




