

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Pisinemo District Security Officer Program Budget Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 96-441

WHEREAS, at a meeting of the Pisinemo District Council held on September 5, 1996, discussion was held pertaining to the Pisinemo District's Security Officer Program budget request; and

WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District currently employs six (6) security officers (2 in San Simon, 2 in Pisinemo and 2 in Santa Cruz) who work the night shift; and

WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District Council is aware that there is a large volume of illegal activity(ies) that occur within the Pisinemo District not only during the evening hours but also during the day to which the same security officers are called upon to investigate if such occurrence occurs during the daytime hours or during the scheduled days off of the currently employed security officers; and

WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District Council does feel that an addition of six (6) security officers to cover the day shift would be beneficial for the safety of the people of the Pisinemo District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pisinemo District's FY97 budget cannot cover the expenditures of this proposed budget due to the limited amount of funds given to the District through the Tohono O'odham Nation's Gaming Revenue distribution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Pisinemo District is hereby requesting that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council appropriate funds for the requested amount of the Pisinemo District Security Officer Program budget.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation hereby approves the Pisinemo District's Security Officer Program budget submitted for approval.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 13TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,340.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 536.0 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
