**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is devoted to the goals of protecting the
environment and safe guarding the health and well being of the
Nation's members; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is committed to protecting, preserving,
and asserting its sovereignty in all matters; and**

**WHEREAS, in the past and in the present, air quality issues have threatened the
environment, health and well being, and the sovereignty of the
Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the U.S, Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region IX has
announced that it has reserved Federal Clean Air Act (CAA) funding
for the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation has prepared a project proposal for funding under the
CAA §103 grant funding with a budget and budget justification; and**

**WHEREAS, this grant will allow the Nation to achieve the goals of (1) protecting
the health and well-being of the O'odham members and their**

neighbors, (2) protecting the environment, and (3) protecting,
preserving, and asserting tribal sovereignty; and

WHEREAS, these goals will be achieved by the project tasks which are to hire
and train staff, compile data and prioritize source categories, draft
a Tohono O'odham Nation Air Code, develop an air emissions
inventory, and solicit public input; and

WHEREAS, the findings of the project will assist the Tohono O'odham Nation in
determining whether or not they would like to pursue primacy
under the CAA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council (Council) hereby approves the Tohono O'odham Nation CAA
§103 grant application to the EPA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council accepts the grant funding that EPA
has reserved for the Tohono O'odham Nation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council approves the attached budget and
authorizes the expenditure of CAA §103 funds according to this
budget.
