RESOLUTION NO. 96-463

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's fiscal year for FY 96 ends on
September 30, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement program has been operating on fund balances
carried forward from its original special appropriation authorized in
FY 94; and

WHEREAS, the Scholarship Fund has also been operating on its original special
appropriation authorized in FY 95; and

WHEREAS, these funds for both the Law Enforcement and the Scholarship Fund
will be depleted at the end of this current fiscal year and will
require new special appropriations; and

WHEREAS, it is the Tohono O'odham Nation's desire not to interrupt the
operations for the law Enforcement Program and the Scholarship
Fund; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Legislative Budget and Finance
Committee, concurred with by the Chairman of the Nation to permit
the continuation of operations of these two programs for 90 days

beyond October 1, 1996, provided that funds shall be appropriated prior to the expiration date of this authorization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the Law Enforcement Program and the Scholarship Fund to continue operations at spending levels equal to the base budget as submitted in order that services will not be interrupted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the budgets for these operations shall be reviewed and submitted for consideration and approval by this council no later than the December General Session of the Legislative Council.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this continuing resolution shall expire December 31, 1996.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 26TH. day of SEPTEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(3), of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
