

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Approval of the Tohono O'odham Nation Superfund Block Cooperative Agreement to the EPA, acceptance of the reserved funding under CORE and PA/SI, and authorization of expenditure in accordance with attached budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 96-464

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is devoted to the goals of protecting the environment and safe guarding the health and well being of the Nation's members; and

WHEREAS, there is a significant concern about pollution that has occurred or may occur to threaten the environment or the health and well being of the Nation's members; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region IX has announced that it has reserved funding under the Superfund Preliminary Assessment/Site Investigation (PA/SI) as well as the Core program for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Nation has prepared a grant proposal for funding under Superfund with a budget and budget justification; and

WHEREAS, this grant will allow the Nation to develop a contingency plan, a clean up code, and a clean up fund for the Nation; and

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WHEREAS, this will allow the Nation to develop the capacity to address environmentally impaired sites and to better respond to environmental emergencies..

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (Council) hereby approves the Tohono O'odham Nation Superfund Block Cooperative Agreement Grant Application to the EPA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council accepts the grant funding that EPA has reserved for the Tohono O'odham Nation.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Council approves the attached budget and authorizes the expenditure of Superfund funds according to this budget.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 26TH. day of SEPTEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,423.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 336.0 NOT VOTING; and 117.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(c)(2).(d), of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
