

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

4 **WHEREAS,** at an emergency meeting of the Pisinemo District Council held on
5
6 **Wednesday, September 25, 1996, discussion was held with regard to**
7
8 **the Pisinemo District's account under the Tohono O'odham Nation**
9 **which is currently deposited with Bank of America; and**

10 **WHEREAS,** the 1997 budget of the Pisinemo District for FY 1997 was presented
11
12 **to the Legislative Council on Friday, September 13, 1996 where the**
13
14 **District Chairperson and Treasurer were informed by the Budget and**
15 **Finance Committee Chairperson, Mary Ann Antone, that the Pisinemo**
16 **District's FY 1997 would be tabled pending review of the Pisinemo**
17 **District's account by the Budget & Finance Committee; and**

20 **WHEREAS,** after meeting with the Budget & Finance Committee held on Friday,
21
22 **September 20, 1996, the Pisinemo District revised their FY 1997**
23 **Budget and is hereby resubmitting the final budget for approval in**
24 **the amount of \$605,786.00; and**

26 **WHEREAS,** the total amount of the Pisinemo District's FY 1997 budget does

28 **exceed the District's allocation from the Gaming Revenue in an**

3 amount of \$11,888.46.00, the Pisinemo District does have monies
4
5 available in its account to cover this exceeded amount; and

6 **WHEREAS,** Resolution #96-08 of the Pisinemo District Council stated that the
7
8 Pisinemo District requests transfer of all Pisinemo District accounts
9
10 currently deposited with the Bank of American to a separate account
11
12 of the Pisinemo District to be handled by the Pisinemo District's
13
14 Treasurer and Administrative Assistant under the direction of the
15
16 Pisinemo district's Chairperson and/or Vice Chairperson, However,
17
18 due to unforeseen circumstances, this request for the transfer of
19
20 monies will not be requested at this time and all monies of the
21
22 Pisinemo District will remain with the Tohono O'odham Nation's
23
24 Accounting Department.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Pisinemo district Council is hereby
26
27 submitting their FY 1997 budget for approval in the amount of
28
\$605,786.00 which includes a budgeted amount of \$80,000.00 to be
distributed to the Pisinemo District Communities of Kupk/Dirtburn,
santa Cruz, Pisinemo, and San Simon in equal distributions of

3 \$20,000.00 each to be used to assist the residents of each community
4 as they see the need for such use.

6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Pisinemo District Council requests the one
7 half (1/2) or \$302,893.00 of the total amount of the Pisinemo
8 District's FY 1997 budget be allocated to the District for FY 1997
9 expenditures for the first six (6) months (October 1, 1996 through
10 March 31, 1997) and the remainder to be placed in an investment
11 account to earn interest until April 1997. Said monies set aside will
12 be available to the District's use on April 1, 1997.

16 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Legislative Council
17 hereby approves the Pisinemo District's FY 1997 budget submitted
18 for approval.

21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the
22 26TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present
23 with a vote 1,759.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 117.0 [05] ABSENT,
24 pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(3), of the
25 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
26 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
27 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16
28 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


