

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Tohono O'odham FY 1996 Water Resources Study Program Budget**  
**Modification No. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 96-469**

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5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Water**  
6 **Resources Study Program under P.L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau**  
7 **of Indian Affairs; and**

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9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation did submit an FY 1996 Water Resources**  
10 **Study Re-Contract Proposal in the amount of \$1,610,371.00 to the**  
11 **Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to Resolution No. 95-265; and**

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14 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Central Office, did notify the Nation**  
15 **that funds have been identified in the amount of \$562,475.00 for the**  
16 **Water Resources Study Program for FY 1996; and**

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19 **WHEREAS, the funding is identified under the Bureau of Indian Affairs, SF 30**  
20 **documents, AMENDMENT OF SOLICITATION/MODIFICATION OF**  
21 **CONTRACT, with Modification No. 5 in the amount of \$16,400.00;**  
22 **Modification No. 6 in the amount of \$8,000.00 and Modification No.**  
23 **7 in the amount of \$538,075.00; and**  
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**WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program does submit for review and approval of Budget Modification No. 1 reflecting the amount of \$562,475.00.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the budget modification and authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 26TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,759.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 117.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d),(3), of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**

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


