

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of Arizona Department of Public Safety Victims of Crime Act Victim Assistance Grant Program to the Tohono O'odham Victim/Witness Program)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 96-472**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is fully authorized to act on behalf of our members in matters arising under the Indian Self-Determination Act of 1975, P.L. 93-638, as amended, 25 U.S.C. 450 et. seq., (hereafter the Act); and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council is empowered to act for and on behalf of its Tohono O'odham Members in adopting resolutions; and**

**WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Public Safety receives money from the Federal Government under the Victims of Crime Act with certain monies set aside specifically for Indian Tribes; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has established a Victim/Witness Program and said program has applied for and been granted funds under DPS Contract No. 96-965 from the Arizona Department of Public Safety in the amount of \$13,772.00 all pending acceptance by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**

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**WHEREAS, these funds will be used to purchase and install a computer system and a fax machine for the Victim/Witness Program; and**

**WHEREAS, the use of the computer system and fax machine will aid the Victim/Witness Program to better track victims of crime, defendants, and the statistics generated thereby; and**

**WHEREAS, said tracking and statistics are very important when seeking additional funding from the Arizona Department of Public Safety and other agencies; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council must approve the acceptance of said grant, and that acceptance of said grant requires the execution of DPS Contract No. 96-965 between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Arizona Department of Public Safety; and**

**WHEREAS, this resolution shall remain in effect until such time as this resolution has been fully completed, expressly rescinded or modified by the Legislative Council.**

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**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby supports and approves the Chairman or his designee to execute DPS Contract No. 96-965 with the Arizona Department of Public Safety for the purchase and installation of a computer system and fax machine as is more fully outlined within said contract.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 26TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 923.0 FOR; 574.0 AGAINST; 262.0 NOT VOTING; and 117.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d),(3), of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


