6 **fully recognizes the hazards tobacco products has on the health and**

8 **overall well-being of the O'odham, especially pregnant women and**  
9 **youth; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Executive and Legislative actively supports tobacco**

12 **cessation programs and education to the O'odham to inform the**

14 **public of the risks associated with the consumption of tobacco**  
15 **products; and**

16 **WHEREAS, Department of Human Services and Division of Community Health**

18 **Services has recently been awarded a subcontract from the State of**

20 **Arizona Department Health Services in the amount of \$18,000.00 for**  
21 **technical support to Health Care Providers addressing the issues**  
22 **surrounding use of tobacco products; and**

24 **WHEREAS, part of this technical support will be to coordinate Health Care**

26 **providers' activities and provide materials to the nation's schools for**  
27 **the purpose of increasing awareness on smoking cessation; and**

**WHEREAS,** such technical support and education will actively involve the Nation's communities and villages in addressing the problems of tobacco use.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the Department of Human Services and Division of Community Health Services' plans to educate the public about the health risks associated with tobacco use and approves the nation's subcontracting with the State of Arizona Department of Health Services for \$18,000 to provide technical support and education of the risks of tobacco use.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Legislative Council hereby approves the appropriation of \$18,000 from the State of Arizona and strongly encourages the Department of Human Services and the Division of Community Health Services to proceed with programs for tobacco cessation to the communities of the Tohono O'odham Nation.
