13 **(AHCCCS) Director and the Arizona Long Term Care Services (ALTCS)**

WHEREAS, this Continuing Resolution requests authorization to continue at the funding level of \$131,552 as stipulated in Resolution No. 95-529.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it supports this continuing Resolution and hereby authorizes the Division of Senior Services to continue operating the ALTCS Program under the initial start up budget in the amount of \$131,552 and that this start up budget of \$131,552.00 be continued until the 1997 ALTCS Tribal Supplement Budget has been approved.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 7TH day of OCTOBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2), of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
