WHEREAS, it is recognized that a Start-Up Budget was needed to begin the Program, and the Department of Human Services staff developed an eight (8) month budget in the amount of \$131,552.00 for Case Management and Support Costs; and

WHEREAS, the 1997 ALTCS Tribal Supplemental Budget has not been approved, it is necessary for a Continuing Resolution to allow the Division of Senior Services to continue to operate the ALTCS Program; and
