RESOLUTION NO. 96-480

WHEREAS, the Administration Support Unit (ASU), an entity under the Department of Human Services (DHS) was previously funded under the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Self-Determination Act (638) Social Services Contract; and

WHEREAS, in Fiscal Year 1996, the BIA Social Services Budget was decreased by 19% and caused a budget deficit in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, in order to avoid another deficit in the Social Services Contract Budget for Fiscal Year 1997, the Department of Human Services submitted a supplement budget request for the ASU; and

WHEREAS, the administrative services provided by ASU is critical to the Department of Human Services; and

WHEREAS, the Supplemental Budget request have not been reviewed or approved; and

WHEREAS, there are current personnel in the Administrative Support Unit and DHS must identify funds to cover these positions; and

WHEREAS, it has been identified that line item funds are available under the Budget of the Office of the Executive Director; and

5 **(ASU) be funded for two months from the Budget of the Executive**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the proposal to modify the Office of**
12 **the Executive Director FY 1997 Base Budget to fund three**
13 **Administrative Support Unit (ASU) positions for two months is**
14 **reviewed and approved by the Legislative Council.**

21 **Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
22 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
23 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16**
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
