RESOLUTION NO. 96-484

**WHEREAS, pursuant to TERO Ordinance No. 01-85, there is created a Tribal
Employment Rights (TERO) Commission; and**

**WHEREAS, the TERO Ordinance provides that the Commission shall be composed
of five (5) members; and**

**WHEREAS, there currently exists on the TERO Board of Commissioners three
vacancies with staggered terms; and**

**WHEREAS, by public notices from the TERO Director the three vacancies were
announced and the eleven districts were notified to submit nominees
for consideration; and**

**WHEREAS, at the Legislative General Session in September, 1996, the Judiciary
Committee, having oversight, did submit the names of Phillip Antone,
Chester Delgado, and Francisco Jose, Jr. and recommended
certification of these individuals to the TERO Board of
Commissioners; and**

**WHEREAS, Phillip Antone, Chester Delgado, and Francisco Jose, Jr. were
appointed on an Interim basis by Chairman Edward D. Manuel in**
