WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is fully authorized to act on behalf of
our members in matters arising under the Indian Self-Determination
Act of 1975, P.L. 93-638, as amended, 25 U.S.C. 450 et. seq.,
(hereinafter the Act); and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is empowered to act for and
on behalf of its Tohono O'odham Members in adopting resolutions;
and

WHEREAS, on the 26th day of September, 1996, the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council passed Resolution No. 96-472 approving a contract between
the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Tohono O'odham
Victim/Witness Program and the Arizona Department of Public
Safety; and

WHEREAS, after the passing of Resolution No. 96-472 it was requested that the
budget for said contract in the amount of \$13,772.00 be placed in
tribal format and returned to the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council for approval; and

WHEREAS, the budget for said contract has been placed in tribal format and is now before the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for its approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves for the budget for Contract No. 96-965 in the amount of \$13,772.00 as outlined in the attached copy of the base budget.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 8TH day of OCTOBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f), of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
