4 **WHEREAS, Indian Health Service, Office of Environmental Health and**
5 **Engineering (OEH&E) conducts an assessment of Sanitation Facilities**
6 **Deficiencies, annually; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Office of Environmental Health and Engineering assessment does**
9 **have an impact upon congressional appropriations and IHS allocation**
10 **of funds; and**

13 **WHEREAS, Indian Health Services has provided for Tribal Priority ranking of**
14 **the four (4) most critical projects and does allocate points impacting**
15 **upon overall prioritization of projects; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Office of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided**
19 **recommendations to the Tohono O'odham Nation regarding the most**
20 **critical needs.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation has**
23 **reviewed and approved the entire priority list and has determined**
24 **that the following deficiencies are the four most critical and**
25 **desirable, in descending order of prioritization:**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council authorizes the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to execute Memorandums of Agreement with the Indian Health Service for activity relating to these projects, including construction and the hiring of consultants, for the projects listed on the attached priority list, provided that this Resolution shall have no effect on the right of the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority to be given a First Right of Refusal on all Indian Health Service construction contracts under P.L. 93-638, pursuant to Resolution No. 94-075.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 8TH. day of OCTOBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(c)(2), (f) & (j), of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
