- 3. Increasing the monthly estimated cost for gasoline
- 4. Including the purchase of uniforms
- 5. Including the purchase of three (3) night scopes
- 6. Including the purchase of an additional two (2) radios

WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District Security Officer Program budget submitted for approval on Friday, September 13, 1996 was not the revised budget; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of the revised Security Officer Program budget totaled to an amount of \$348,892.00, a difference of \$72,150.00 of the
