RESOLUTION NO. 96-499

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is committed to the protection of the health and safety of its people and natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes that one effective way to ensure the protection of its people and resources is to gather information about potential hazards and develop plans to cope with any possible emergencies or disasters; and

WHEREAS, in 1986, the Congress of the United States passed the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act, Title III (SARA III) that provides a framework to gather this type of information, and create emergency plans; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation has authorized the creation of a Workgroup that will address the issues of bringing the Nation into compliance with SARA Title III in a manner that best benefits the Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has approved, in Resolution No. 96-169, the submission of a grant application to the Federal Emergency

Management Agency (FEMA) to provide training to the SARA Title III Workgroup; and

WHEREAS, FEMA has awarded funds in the amount of \$9,799.00 to the Nation for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the expenditure of funds from this grant from FEMA for the purposes of training the SARA Title III Workgroup.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 9TH day of OCTOBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,509.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 52.5 NOT VOTING; and 314.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f), of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
