

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**

**RESOLUTION NO. 96-549**

**WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 08-70 the Nation established the Papago Tribal Utility Authority, now known as Tohono O'odham Utility Authority (TOUA), for purposes of constructing, maintaining, and operating various utility systems within the Nation to be owned wholly by the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on 08 January 1992, did pass Resolution No. 92-012 (Granting Cellular Telephone Service Certificate of Convenience), and with legislation of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 enacted, said Resolution must be modified to include paging services and related facilities; and**

**WHEREAS, agencies on and within the Tohono O'odham Nation providing public safety and emergency services currently utilize a paging service system which has proven to be of substantial benefit for the general welfare of the Nation and its respective members; and**

**WHEREAS, with the Telecommunications Act 1996, the Authority can not deny future telecommunications service companies the opportunity to serve**

both within and beyond the boundaries of the Tohono O'odham  
Nation; and

**WHEREAS, TOUA has respectfully submitted all documents (attached hereto and  
incorporated herein by reference) to establish the need and support  
for paging services and related facilities; and**

**WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council approved the requested revisions of Gu  
Achi District Council Resolution No. 0192-44, by its District Council  
Resolution No. 1196-136, and recommends further approval thereof  
by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**

**WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee has reviewed the request by TOUA  
to provide alone, or in conjunction with others, a paging service and  
related facilities, to be present within the approved TOUA Cellular  
Telephone Site on Jewak Mountain, Gu Achi District, Tohono  
O'odham Nation, and recommends its approval.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
Council does hereby approve TOUA to provide alone or in**

conjunction with others, a paging service and related facilities, and  
with respect to the Telecommunications Act of 1996, future  
telecommunications service companies and related facilities as  
feasible, to be present at the approved TOUA Cellular Telephone Site  
on Jewak Mountain, Gu Achi District, Tohono O'odham Nation.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 2ND  
day of DECEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the  
powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (c)(4) and i(1) & (2) of the  
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham  
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16  
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
