5 **WHEREAS,** on November 21, 1996 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council held

7 a joint meeting and a subsequent meeting on December 3, 1996,  
8  
9 with the District Chairperson's Association, including district council  
10 members from within the eleven districts; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the joint meeting raised numerous concerns, issues, and requests on  
12  
13 the status and use of generated gaming revenue; and

14 **WHEREAS,** it is the desire of the Legislative Council to provide for and address  
15  
16 the needs of the Tohono O'odham; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council has determined that the most feasible  
18  
19 approach to the development of a plan of action which would begin  
20  
21 the process of providing gaming revenue to the Tohono O'odham,  
22  
23 would be through the establishment of a Task Force On Gaming  
24 Revenue.

2. The task force is commissioned with the primary purpose to review, identify, develop and recommend to the Council, a plan that would clearly outline a process whereby gaming revenue would become available for the benefit of the Tohono O'odham.

3. The task force is empowered to perform its duties and responsibilities in accordance with the Proposal to Establish the Task Force On Gaming Revenue.

The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 3RD. day of DECEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present and by a vote of 575.0 FOR; 1,019.5 AGAINST; 281.5 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, failed to pass because it did not receive a majority of the votes cast as required by Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation.
