

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Authorizing the purchase of Equipment to provide Emergency Response**  
**to Tohono O'odham Nation)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 96-559**

**WHEREAS, the Fire Department is in need of emergency response vehicles to provide adequate services to the members of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is aware of the needs that exist throughout the Tohono O'odham Nation in the areas of Fire protection and fire safety; and**

**WHEREAS, in order to provide adequate services to all areas of the Tohono O'odham Nation, quality equipment must be provided to meet the needs of the members of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance and Commerce Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recommends that the proposed contract to secure quality fire equipment trucks be negotiated by the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Nation, the Chief of the Fire Department and the Attorney General to negotiate the contract with Pierce Manufacturing, Inc.**

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**(Authorizing the purchase of Equipment to provide Emergency Response to Tohono O'odham Nation)**

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
**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the deferred plan to purchase 3 fully equipped fire engine trucks and one pumper tanker for the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department, the deferred payment plan with authorized payment to be made in Fiscal Year 1998.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 5TH day of DECEMBER, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (c)(2 & (d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
