RESOLUTION NO. 97-008

WHEREAS, pursuant to TERO Ordinance No. 01-85, there is created a Tribal
Employment Rights (TERO) Commission; and

WHEREAS, the TERO Ordinance provides that the Commission shall be composed
of five (5) members; and

WHEREAS, the TERO Commission membership shall attend regular and special
meetings to conduct business; and

WHEREAS, a concern has been brought to the attention of the Judiciary
Committee that a newly appointed member, Damascus Francisco, has
missed three meetings consecutively; and

WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee in reviewing TERO Ordinance 01-85, Section
6 (C) where it states, in part ... "The "Legislative" Council may
remove a member of the Commission for inefficiency, neglect of
duty, malfeasance, misfeasance or nonfeasance in office."; and

WHEREAS, at the December 06, 1996 General Session, the Legislative Council, did
discuss in brief the above and recommended that the foregoing

resolution be referred to the Judiciary Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Judiciary Committee now recommends to the Legislative Council that appropriate action be taken, which is to remove Damascus Francisco from the TERO Board of Commissioners.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Judiciary Committee provide official notice of advertisement to the TERO Board of Commission not to exceed thirty (30) days to the general public of the Tohono O'odham Nation.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Legislative Council address the appointments to the TERO Board of Commission at its next general session in February 1997.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 8TH day of JANUARY, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,280.5 FOR; 438.5 AGAINST; 157.0 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (b) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


