RESOLUTION NO. 97-016

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency notified the
Tohono O'odham Nation of funds availability for U.S.-Mexico Border
Grants Projects for use to sponsor an International
Educational/Informational Conference for O'odham living on both
sides of the U.S./Mexico border; and

WHEREAS, these funds are limited to use for efforts that will promote the U.S.
Environmental Protection Agency's efforts at implementing the
Border XXI program; and

WHEREAS, the Border XXI Program is new, binational effort to bring together
all entities involved in and responsible for the border environment
and to work cooperatively toward sustainable development of border
regions; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council approves of this
opportunity and the pre-proposal submitted in response to this offer
of grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




