 Committee, the Commerce Committee and the Budget and Finance
 Committee; and

WHEREAS, these budget modifications are as follows: Moving \$9,500 from Sif
 Oidak Labor line item to the Sif Oidak Materials line item; moving
 \$5,141 from Baboquivari Labor line item to Baboquivari Materials
