5 **to address storm damage from a 1993 storm that swept through the**  
6 **Nation and this grant was the Imminent Threat Grant, issued**  
7 **through the United States Department of Housing and Urban**

11 **WHEREAS, the grant requires a budget modification to make the appropriate**  
12 **and necessary adjustments to the grant budget and to create a new**  
13 **line item for Sub Contracts to expedite completion of the roof**  
14 **repairs and grant close-out; and**

17 **WHEREAS, these budget modifications have been reviewed and approved by the**  
18 **following entities and committees of the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
19 **Council: Grants and Contracts in Accounting, the Executive**  
20 **Committee, the Commerce Committee and the Budget and Finance**

25 **WHEREAS, these budget modifications are as follows: Moving \$9,500 from Sif**  
26 **Oidak Labor line item to the Sif Oidak Materials line item; moving**

line item; moving all funds from both the Labor and Materials line items in the Hickiwan, Gu Achi, Gu Vo and Schuk Toak Districts, that amount being a total of \$110,188, to a new line item for Sub-Contracts.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves of the proposed budget modifications to the Imminent Threat Grant in order to expedite completion of this grant and getting the benefit to the people of the Tohono O'odham Nation.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 10TH day of JANUARY, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,629.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 247.0 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
