

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(U.S. DOL Notice of Intent - July 01, 1997 - June 30, 1999)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 97-024**

**WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act was enacted into law in 1982,**  
**replacing the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA);**

**and**

**WHEREAS, funding is made available from the United States Department of**  
**Labor, Division of Indian and Native American Programs (U.S.**  
**DOL/DINAP), to tribal governments to establish programs for**  
**improving the employment prospects of eligible persons; and**

**WHEREAS, pursuant to P.L. 970-300 Section 632.10 (C)(4) Standard Form 424**  
**and statement indicating that the Nation meets the requirements of**  
**Section 632.10 (C)(4) must be submitted to the USDOL/DINAP by**  
**January 01 of the designation year; and**

**WHEREAS, the JTPA Program has submitted for review the Standard Form 424,**  
**Notice of Intent to Apply for Funds and the statement from the**  
**Nation pursuant to Section 632.10 (C)(4) for Program Years 1997 -**  
**1999.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
**Council hereby approves the submission of the Standard Form 424**

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Notice of Intent to Apply for Funds, and the statement that the Nation does meet the requirements of Section 632.10 (C)(4).

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the Notice of Intent, provided however, that any amendments affecting it shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 14TH day of JANUARY, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,629.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 247.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


