

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Override Vetoed Resolution No. 97-002, "Override vetoed Resolution No.
96-559, Authorizing the purchase of Equipment to provide Emergency
Response to Tohono O'odham Nation")**

RESOLUTION NO. 97-029

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did approve Resolution No. 97-002, by a vote equal to two-thirds of the votes cast, thereby overriding the objections made by the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to Resolution No. 96-559 in accordance with Article VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation has improperly purported to veto a portion of Resolution No. 97-002, without authority of law; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council believes that such purported veto is without effect, but wishes to resolve this issue as expeditiously as possible, in order to move forward to provide necessary emergency and fire services for this Nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that in the event that such action may be necessary, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby override the Chairman's purported veto of Resolution No. 97-002.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this action is taken to reaffirm the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council's earlier action with respect to Resolution No. 97-002, without conceding that such additional action is necessary, and while maintaining that Resolution No. 97-002 is already law by virtue of action taken by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on January 6, 1997.

The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 15TH. day of JANUARY, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present and with a vote of 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 07 ABSENT, was passed by majority of at least TWO-THIRDS (2/3) [1,251.0] of the votes cast as required by Section V of Article VII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.
