4 **WHEREAS, Ms. Frances Francisco, Chairwoman of the Schuk Toak**
5 **District filed an Accusation for Removal ("Accusation")**
6 **against Mr. Kenneth J. Antone, Schuk Toak District**
7 **Representative, with the Judiciary Committee in**
8 **accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article IX**
9 **of the Uniform Election Ordinance, alleging Gross**
10 **Neglect of Duty and Moral Turpitude; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee did conduct a preliminary**
13 **hearing on January 27 & 28, 1997 and by Resolution No.**
14 **JUD-01-97 did determine that there is reasonable cause**
15 **to believe that the accused has committed a removable**
16 **offense as charged in the Accusation; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee, in accordance with the**
19 **provisions of Section 2.D. of Article IX of the Uniform**
20 **Election Ordinance has filed the resolution and**
21 **Accusation with the Secretary of the Legislative Council;**

24 **WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Legislative Council to set a**
25 **hearing date on the Accusation. The Uniform Election**
26 **Code provides for the Legislative Council to set a**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED THAT:

- 1. A hearing on the Accusation against Kenneth J. Antone, Legislative Representative from Schuk Toak District will be held on Monday, February 24, 1997 at 9 a.m. in the Council Chambers of the Legislative Council in Sells, Arizona.**
- 2. The Secretary of the Legislative Council shall provide copies of (a) the Accusation against Mr. Kenneth J. Antone, (b) Resolution No. JUD-01-97 of the Judiciary Committee, (c) the Special Rules of Procedure Upon Accusation for Removal, and (d) notice of the date and time for the removal hearing to Mr. Kenneth J. Antone and Ms. Frances Francisco not less than ten (10) days before the hearing on the accusation.**

The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 5TH day of FEBRUARY, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (l) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
