members contracts its own Law Enforcement Program
under P.L. 93-638; and**

**WHEREAS, since the increase in the number of Police Officers to the
Tohono O'odham Police Department there is a need to
increase equipment and related operating expenses; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department has identified
specific areas of proposed increased equipment and related
operating expenses; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation
supports the Tohono O'odham Police Department in their
request to increase the funding under P.L. 93-638 to provide
for increased equipment and related operating expenses.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Appropriations Committee
are hereby authorized and directed to bring this request to
the appropriate agencies and members and committees of
Congress.**




