**RESOLUTION NO. 97-074**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has through Resolution Nos. 18-83, 95-066 and 96-112 reaffirmed an interest in acquiring the Eastern portion of Baboquivari Peak as a part of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Baboquivari Peak is crucial and considered sacred to the O'odham of this Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, acquiring the said Peak will be made whole, thereby preserving its significance to the O'odham.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby supports and approves acquiring the eastern portion of Baboquivari Peak and requesting the Arizona congressional delegation to support the Tohono O'odham Nation's requests for a memorial in acquiring the eastern portion of the Baboquivari Peak.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation claim all the lands constituting the Baboquivari Peak and mountain as the central sacred and culture site of the O'odham and respectfully requests the transfer of the lands constituting the eastern slope to the Tohono O'odham Nation.**
