

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of "Community Participation to Develop a Nutrition
Activation Program for the Prevention of Diabetes Among
the Tohono O'odham" Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 97-080

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has recognized the health of
members as one of its highest priorities; and**

**WHEREAS, the disease of Diabetes Mellitus (Diabetes) has been
identified by community members and the medical
profession as a major health concern facing the Tohono
O'odham; and**

**WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services, Division of Community
Health Services has identified the need to expand the
Department's prevention efforts through the coordination
of education and support services and increase
participation of community members; and**

**WHEREAS, St Louis, Missouri, Washington University's Diabetes
Research and Training Center has proposed a collaborative
effort between the Kathryn M. Buder Center for American
Indian Studies, The Graduate School of Social Work, the
School of Medicine and the Tohono O'odham Department of
Human Services for the development and demonstration of
a community process to provide for increased community
participation in the prevention of diabetes among the
Tohono O'odham;**

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3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services along**
4 **with the Division of Community Health Services reviewed**
5 **the proposal and agreed to participate in the proposed**
6 **collaborative effort because there is a great need and**
7 **assistance is needed in the prevention of diabetes among the**
8 **Tohono O'odham; and**

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10 **WHEREAS, this proposal if approved will last five years and will initiate**
11 **a partnership between St. Louis, Missouri, Washington**
12 **University's Diabetes Research and Training Center and the**
13 **Tohono O'odham Nation through the Department of Human**
14 **Services, Division of Community Health Services, which will**
15 **benefit the Tohono O'odham members by making changes**
16 **in Nutrition with education and accepting prevention**
17 **activities with changes in life habits and Washington**
18 **University will benefit by having their masters level social**
19 **work students who are American Indians in Community**
20 **Health train in promotion strategies and the dietary,**
21 **behavioral and social factors associated with Non-Insulin**
22 **Dependent Diabetes Mellitus (NIDDM).**

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26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed project**
27 **"Community Participation to Develop a Nutrition Activation**

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Program for the Prevention of Diabetes Among the Tohono O'odham" has been reviewed and approved by the Tohono O'odham Nation's Executive Office and the Legislative Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Office and the Legislative Council approves the establishment of a partnership between St. Louis, Missouri, Washington University's Diabetes Research and Training Center and the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Department of Human Services, Division of Community Health Services.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 3RD. day of MARCH, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,771.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 105.0 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) & (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
