

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving First Amendment to Patented Mining Claim Purchase
Agreement Between the University of Arizona and the Tohono
O'odham Nation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 97-086

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5 **WHEREAS, the University of Arizona and the Tohono O'odham Nation**
6 **entered into a Patented Mining Claim Purchase Agreement**
7 **("Agreement"), attached hereto, on April 15, 1996, which**
8 **provided that if the purchase transaction contemplated in**
9 **the Agreement is not completed within ten (10) months of the**
10 **date of the Agreement, either party has the option to cancel**
11 **the Agreement by giving written notice to the other party;**

14 **and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Agreement related to purchase of four (4) mining claims,**
16 **namely the Senator No. 1, Sunbeam No. 1, Minnie Mine No. 1,**
17 **and the Santo Tomas mill site; and**

19 **WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 96-083 the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
20 **Council approved the Agreement and appropriated \$22,000**
21 **to accomplish the land purchase; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the purchase transaction has not been completed within the**
24 **10 months specified; and**

25 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation remains committed to**
26 **completing the purchase transaction and wishes to extend**
27 **the time period for completion of the transaction**

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3 **contemplated in the Agreement by an additional ten (10)**
4
5 **months, and is informed that the University of Arizona**
6 **agrees to do the same; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee and the Budget and**
8 **Finance Committee of the Legislative Council have reviewed**
9 **this resolution and recommend its approval by the**
10 **Legislative Council.**

11
12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
13 **Council approves the First Amendment to the Agreement in**
14 **the form attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairman of**
15 **the Tohono O'odham Nation to sign it.**

17 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
18 **Council reappropriates \$22,000 from the Nation's portion of**
19 **mining revenues for the purchase of the four (4) patented**
20 **mining claims named above.**

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23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**
24 **Council on the 6TH. day of MARCH, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum**
25 **was present with a vote of 1,629.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and**
26 **247.0 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**
27 **VI, Section 1(f) and Section 9 of Article XVI of the Constitution of the**
28 **Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on**
January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
