

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(In support of the Tohono O'odham Education Department's Grant  
Application for Expansion of Library Services)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 97-093**

**WHEREAS, the United States Department of Education, Library Services for Indian tribes - Basic Grants program, has issued its 1997 Application for Grants Under the Library Services for Indian Tribes and Hawaiian Natives Program; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Education Department has submitted for review and approval a proposal for fiscal year 1998 for the Tohono O'odham Library Services under the Library Services for Indian Tribes and Hawaiian Natives Program for the purposes of improving library services to O'odham people residing on or near the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the proposal deadline date is February 24, 1997, for basic grant funds to be used between October 1, 1997 and September 30, 1998 for eligible activities under the Basic Grants Program.**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Education Department is hereby submitting a budget in the amount of \$4,602.00 which is to be used for the purchase of books and supplies.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the proposal for the Tohono**

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**(In support of the Tohono O'odham Education Department's Grant Application for Expansion of Library Services)**

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**O'odham Library Services to the U.S. Department of Education, Library Services for Indian Tribes - Basic Grants program.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no executed grant has been awarded by the U.S. Department of Education, Library Services for Indian Tribes - Basic Grants program.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman, and any designated official are hereby authorized to execute the grant application, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for further approval.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Nation to waive the indirect cost in the amount of \$668.67 and that said amount is transferred to line item 722.00 Program Supplies.**

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 7TH day of MARCH, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,297.0 FOR; 419.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 160.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
