WHEREAS, the O'odham who share this hope, in sincere O'odham spirit, want to provide a forum for all O'odham who want to be proactive in strengthening their personal wellness; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Wellness Planning Committee has been active in informing and soliciting the participation of the Districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby acknowledges the problems facing the

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves a budget in the amount of \$45,414.32 to support the First Annual Tohono O'odham Wellness Conference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds will be appropriated from the General Revenue Account.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all monies expended will be accounted for and that any funds not expended will be returned to the Tohono O'odham Nation General Fund.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 7TH. day of MARCH, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,716.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 160.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
