## RESOLUTION NO. 97-115

4 WHEREAS. on April 3, 1997, pursuant to Section 7(D)(1) of Article XII of 5 the Tohono O'odham Nation Uniform Election Ordinance, 6 Ord. No. 03-86 (the "Election Ordinance"), the Election Board 7 filed with the Office of the Tohono O'odham Legislative 8 9 Council documents entitled (1) O'odham Use of Gaming 10 **Revenues Initiative Petition No. IN-01-97; (2) Certificate of** 11 Initiative Petition No. IN-01-97; and (3) O'odham Voice on 12 Use of Gaming Revenues Initiative Measure (the "Initiative"); 13 14 and

the Initiative proposes (1) a per capita distribution of \$2,000 WHEREAS. 16 for each enrolled member of the Nation (totalling an 17 estimated \$40 million), with additional per capita 18 19 distributions every two years thereafter; (2) \$30 million to 20 construct and operate five youth centers within the Nation;  $\mathbf{21}$ (3) subsidies of utility bills issued by the Tohono O'odham 22 Utility Authority in an initial amount up to \$1 million, 23 24 adjusted annually, for elderly and low-income members of 25 the Nation; (4) initial funding of \$1 million, plus unspecified 26 overhead, for a charitable organization to provide services 27 to needy members of the Nation; (5) funding in an 28

(Disapproving the Initiative Measure Sponsored by O'odham Voice on **Use of Gaming Revenues and Setting a Special Election)** 1 Page 2 of 5 2 unspecified amount to establish an Economic Task Force 3 and Economic Development Department to promote 4 5 economic development within the Nation; and (6) initial 6 funding of \$15 million to provide grants to members of the 7 Nation for business development; and 8 WHEREAS, the Council discussed the Initiative and assessed its 9 10 implications for the health, safety and welfare of the 11 O'odham: considered the presentation made by two of the 12 three officers of the organization sponsoring the Initiative; 13 and considered the comments of the public expressed at the 14 15 session: and 16 WHEREAS, the intended source of funding for the Initiative is the 17 **Gaming Revenues: and** 18 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has determined that the Initiative 19 20 violates federal law on per capita distribution of gaming 21 revenues and, if implemented, would place at risk all or a 22 substantial portion of existing and future gaming revenues; 23 24 and 25 WHEREAS, the Initiative would cause disgualification of members from 26 public assistance programs and impose income tax liability 27 on funds received; and 28

18	Ordinance, the Legislative Council sets June 28, 1997 as						
19	the date for a special election on the Initiative Measure.
