RESOLUTION NO. 97-138

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did adopt the Solid
Waste Plan and Solid Waste Management Code during the
February Legislative Council Session; and**

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Plan was adopted unfunded; and

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Solid Waste Program did
develop or identify a supplemental budget in the amount of
\$146,036.72 prorated at six months for the implementation
of the Solid Waste Plan; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Solid Waste Program
supplemental budget was approved by the Executive Review
Committee; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Solid Waste Program and Solid
Waste Committee request that this supplemental budget be
adopted immediately so the Solid Waste Plan can be
implemented and all necessary program operations and
positions can be acted upon.**

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials to wit:
the Chairman and any designated official are hereby**

authorized to execute the approved Solid Waste Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds identified in the attached Solid Waste Program Supplemental Budget be approved for expenditures accordingly.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the source of funding be appropriated from the General Revenue Account.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 14TH. day of APRIL, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,734.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 142.0 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(3) the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
