RESOLUTION NO. 97-139

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Tohono O'odham Youth Services program under a three year agreement with United Way of Tucson; and

WHEREAS, this three year agreement expires on June 30,1997; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham people, interested in the welfare of the young people residing on the Tohono O'odham Nation is committed to entering into another three year agreement with United Way of Tucson; and

WHEREAS, the main purpose and goals of the Tohono O'odham Youth Services program is to promote and encourage young Tohono O'odham people in the fields of recreation, education, cultural experiences and youth counseling; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Youth Services and the Tohono O'odham youth need the support, encouragement and involvement from the Tohono O'odham Nation, Districts and community members, in the provision of these services; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Youth Services has submitted a proposal for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby give its full support for the purpose, goals,

and the efforts of the Tohono O'odham Youth Services and authorizes to enter into an Agreement with United Way of Tucson.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of the Agreement will be from July 1, 1997 through June 30, 1998

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the agreement, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this agreement shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 14TH. day of APRIL, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,734.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 142.0 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
