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3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tuberculosis**
4 **Control Services Program to help prevent the spread of the**
5 **disease through community education, prevention, early**
6 **detection, comprehensive regimens and careful follow up**
7 **with individuals; and**

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9 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Tohono O'odham**
10 **Tuberculosis Control Services Program has been provided in**
11 **part through supplemental funding sources; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Services Program**
13 **desires to continue the services it provides to TB susceptible**
14 **patients; and**

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16 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Services Program**
17 **has received funding from the State of Arizona, Department**
18 **of Health Services for its program.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,**

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- 1. That the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the proposal for funding of the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Services Program from the State of Arizona Department of Health Services.**
 - 2. That the duration of this contract shall be from July 01, 1996 and remain in effect as long as the Arizona Department of Health Services agrees to fund the**

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Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Services Program.

3. That the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no executed contract has been awarded by the State of Arizona.

4. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this contract.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 6TH. day of MAY, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
