

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Aquatic & Recreation Center Budget Modification
No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 97-164

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Youth Services program has been assigned to operate and manage the year round maintenance and activities of the Aquatic Recreation Center; and

WHEREAS, these changes will no longer require a managers position; and

WHEREAS, partial funding from the managers salary will be utilized to create (4) new positions to include (2) two full time concession workers and (2) additional full time lifeguards; and

WHEREAS, the concession supervisor position has also been converted to create the (2) full time concession workers; and

WHEREAS, the remaining balance from the managers salary will be distributed into operational line items 650 - training and registration, 720 - supplies office, 721 - supplies other, 770 - repair and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Aquatic and Recreation Center Budget Modification #1 has been reviewed and approved by the oversight


