**RESOLUTION NO. 97-166**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is committed to the protection  
of the health and safety of its people and natural resources;  
and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has passed Resolution No. 96-  
169 to approve the submission of a grant proposal to the  
Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for funds to  
provide training for the Superfund Amendments and  
Reauthorization Act SARA Title III work group; and**

**WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation has authorized  
the creation of a Working Group that will address the issues  
of bringing the Nation into compliance with SARA Title III in  
a manner that best benefits the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has  
funds available to provide training that will enable the  
Tohono O'odham Nation to protect its members and  
resources by coming into compliance with SARA Title III; and**

**WHEREAS, FEMA has awarded funds in the amount of \$9,799.00 to the  
Nation for this purpose; and**

**(Modification No. 1 to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA))**

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3 **WHEREAS, the work group members who are incurring personal**  
4 **expenses to attend meetings and/or training sessions and**  
5 **are not directly employed by the Nation, District or other**  
6 **agency, but are the primary and alternate representative of**  
7 **the SARA Title III work group, need to be compensated for**  
8 **incurring these costs; and**

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11 **WHEREAS, the SARA Title III membership requires lodging and meals**  
12 **for attending training sessions.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
14 **Council hereby approves the Budget Modification of this**  
15 **grant application to the Federal Emergency Management**  
16 **Agency to include per diem, travel expenses and mileage**  
17 **allowance for training members of the Nation's Title III work**  
18 **group.**

27 **approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
28 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
**18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


