

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 1997 Tribal Appropriation Budget Modification - Law Enforcement  
Tohono O'odham Police Department)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 97-172**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation with a land base of 2.8 million acres and a population of 19,255 members contracts its own Law Enforcement Program under P.L. 93-638; and**

**WHEREAS, part of the Law Enforcement contract includes a Nations Ranger Program which has been funded via the P.L. 93-638 contract in the amount of \$525,031.00; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department must reduce its Federal budget of \$2,436,600.00 by amount of the Ranger Program leaving a Police Department budget if \$2,313,329.00; and**

**WHEREAS, the Police Department requests that the 1997 Tribal appropriation be modified to accommodate some of the costs of reducing the Federal budget to satisfy the Ranger Program fiscal requirements; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation supports the Tohono O'odham Police Department in their request to modify their Federal budget to accommodate the Ranger Program.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the  
Tohono O'odham Nation authorizes the implementation of  
the proposed tribal budget modification where the final  
budget dollar amount is unchanged from \$4,065,217.00.**

Council on the 09TH. day of MAY, 1997 at a meeting at which a quorum  
was present with a vote of 1,315.0 FOR; 0 AGAINST; 0 NOT VOTING; and  
561.0 [11] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article  
I, Section 1(d),(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,  
adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and  
approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs  
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


