4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation did on Saturday, May 24, 1997**
5 **conduct a general election for the offices of Representatives**
6 **and Alternates to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council;**

9 **WHEREAS, the Election Board did issue and post its Certification of**
10 **Election Results in accordance with Section 6(E) of Article VII**
11 **of the Uniform Election Ordinance, Certifying to the election**
12 **of the candidates who received the highest number of votes**
13 **for elective office; and**

15 **WHEREAS, under Section 6(N) of Article VII of the Uniform Election**
16 **Ordinance, it is incumbent upon this Council to issue**
17 **Certificates of Election to the candidates who received the**
18 **highest number of votes for each Council seat within twenty**
19 **days after the Election Board has posted its Certificates of**
20 **Election results, provided however, that no election contest**
21 **statement has been filed against the candidates within the**
22 **time allowed and provided for, and provided further that**
23 **they hold no other elective office of the Nation; and**
